**Description:**

The War Horse greatly resembles a Clydesdale horse. Most are white but may have some black to gray mottling on the back and hind quarters.

The primary purpose of the breed was two-fold. First as a powerful work horse - true horse power to move tree stumps, move stone from rock quarries, etc.

At maturity they stand 7 feet at the shoulder and weigh between 1600 and 2400 pounds. Properly harnessed they can pull 7 times their own weight.
